A Christmas Message

Some Statements Taken from Pope John Paul II's Christmas Message December 23, 1959.

"Christmas is with Us, the second Christmas of our pontificate. Gazing at the scene from afar, united in spirit with Mary and Joseph on the road to Bethlehem, We taste a few days in advance the sweetness which come to Us from the angelic hymn announcing the heavenly peace which is offered to all men of good will."

"This (Social Peace) is solidly based on the mutual and reciprocal respect for the personal dignity of man... The Son of God was made man, and His redeeming act concerns not only the collectivity, but also the individual man."

"Oh! May all men of good will return to Christ and listen to His divine teaching... With such a wish and with such a prayer, behold we have arrived, all of us, like Mary and Joseph, like the humble shepherds... and like the Wise Men from the East, before the crib of our Newborn Savior."

"At Bethlehem all men

must find their peace. In the first rank should be Catholics. Today, especially the Church wishes to see them pledged to an effort to make His message of peace a part of themselves."

"The Pope's task is to prepare for God a perfect people (Luke 1:17) which is exactly like the task of (John) the Baptist, who is his patron and from whom he takes his name. And it is not possible to imagine a higher and more precious perfection than that of Christian peace, which is the peace of hearts, peace in the social order, in life, in prosperity, in mutual respect and in the brotherhood of all nations.

Gifts of the Holy Spirit by Mike Chapman

The Holy Spirit is the Voice for God and acts as a reminder to all of God children of the unconditional love that God has for us is only Son. God extended the Holy spirit through Jesus Christ, is beloved Son, as a way to ensure that we would always know these things .It is eternal perspective of Truth, Love, and Reality that cannot be taken from us.

Even though we live in the world and have forgotten their Oneness with God, there is still an inkling left within each of us that causes us to have a tiny bit of the memory that we are One with God. Even with all of the thoughts and beliefs that we have acquire that have caused us to think that we are unworthy, God isn't real, we are fine on our own, or other beliefs that keep us from remembering fully – despite all of that- there is still a glimmering within us that we are One with God. Somewhere deep inside, we remember that God is our true Creator and the source whom we yearn to return Home to.

When we can hear God we can step and seek peace and love in our hearts, in our minds, in our love, and in the world so that we are living is an expression of Jesus Christ and the Father.

In Christian Theology Charity, OR LOVE by Joe DeRitis

Love, in this sense of an unlimited loving-kindness towards all others, as is referred to as Universal Love, is held to be the ultimate perfection of the human spirit, because it is said to both glorify and reflect the nature of God. In its most extreme form such love can be self-sacrificial. To include it under the same category as the virtue of Charity may be misguided as it stands alone as the greatest virtue of all. This love is necessary for salvation, and with it no one can be lost.

Charity has two parts: love of God and love of man, which includes both love of one's neighbor and of one self



Paul describes it in the [First Letter to the Corinthians, chapter 13 \(KJV\)](#):

Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal..... I am nothing. And though I bestow all my goods to feed *the poor*, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profited me nothing.

Charity suffered long, *and* is kind; charity envied not; charity vaunted not itself, is not puffed up, Doth not behave itself unseemly, seek not her own, is not easily provoked, think no evil; Rejoiced not in iniquity, but rejoiced in the truth; Bear all things, believe all things, hope all things, endure all things.

When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things. For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.

And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these *is* charity.

Building a Foundation of Hope by Joe DeRitis

Even if you know Jesus as your Savior, you can still lose

hope. We learn from Proverbs that “hope deferred makes the heart sick” (Proverbs 13:12). When our hopes are delayed, we can be overcome by a deep sense of despair. So, how did Abraham do it? How did he remain hopeful for more than two decades? Look at Abraham’s relationship with God: he was a friend of God (2 Chronicles 20:7); he was also God’s servant (Genesis 26:24); and he was totally obedient (Genesis 22). You can do the same. Here are four practical steps you can take every day to build a sure foundation of hope that will carry you through the storms of life:



1. Submit yourself to God. God is the source of our hope. (1 Peter 5:6-7).
2. Strengthen your faith. Allow God’s previously fulfilled promises to renew your hope. (1 Chronicles 16:11-21).
3. Trust God’s timing. Sometimes God answers our prayers and fulfills our hopes quickly. At other times, for His own divine reasons, He allows us to wait
4. Thank God today. Though it’s arduous to rejoice as we wait for hopes to be fulfilled, rejoicing enables God to perfect us in ways we are unable to see at the time. (Romans 5:1-5).

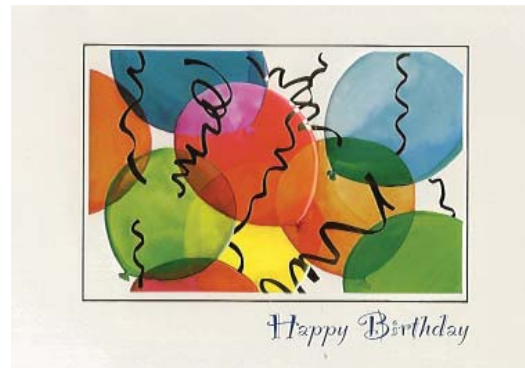
