A letter from Gary Foote, Coordinator of Youth Ministry on our recent donation for students including Gabi participating in this year's "Steubenville West" Conference.

July 22-24, 2011 high school youth from St. Edward the Confessor joined over 2000 other Catholic high school youth for an incredible conference entitled, "Steubenville West." The theme of this year's conference was, "Rooted - As therefore you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so live in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving" – Colossians 2:6-7." Our teens encountered God in a way that many of them had never before. One young lady wrote to me after we returned from our trip, "Steubenville West was something I will never forget. I had lost my way in my faith. I have been through a lot in my life and I had nowhere to turn. But, God works in mysterious ways and I believe that He was with all of us during this trip. God wants all of us to know that He died for each of us individually. Not for us as a whole, but for each of us. God spoke to me this weekend. He was there by my side." This retreat opportunity would not have been available to many of the youth at our parish had it not been for the generous prayers and financial support of the Knights of Columbus. Deputy Grand Knight Message October 2011

Dear Knights of Columbus,

My name is Ryan Holke and I am studying to be a missionary priest in Brazil. Earlier this year, I received a scholarship from the Knights and I wish to express my profound gratitude for your gesture of trust and support for our mission. Truly, every little bit helps and your donation was providential in aiding our cause.

I would like to take this opportunity to tell you all a little bit more about the institute to which I pertain, and the nature of our mission. Our institute is called Father Kolbe Missionaries of the Immaculata (Missionários da Imaculada – Padre Kolbe) and we were founded on February 11, 1997 by Fr. Luigi Faccenda and Fr. Sebastian. Our spirituality consists in offering ourselves completely to Our Lady, the Immaculata, so that in Her, we may be transformed into perfect disciples of Christ and, therefore, seek His will in the day to day situations of our lives, as well as in our apostolate. This total consecration to the Immaculata was intuited by Saint Maximilian Kolbe, who made it the cornerstone of the movement he founded, the *Militia of the Immaculata (MI)*, whose goal is the conversion and sanctification of all people under the protection and through the mediation of Our Lady, using all possible legitimate means. The focus of our apostolic work as an Institute is evangelization, therefore, as a priority we collaborate with the MI, active here in Brazil through Television, Radio, the

Internet, the magazine "*O Milite*", and other means as well. Our principal role within the MI is to form and animate the many lay employees and volunteers who work with it, helping them to deepen the spirituality of total consecration. Although we work closely with the MI, we do not share funds, hence the service we provide is completely gratuitous. As well as collaborating with the MI, we also work extensively with young people and parish communities. Besides this, our specific mission is to be in society, transforming it from the inside out, and in this way, our members can work in any number of professions. All of us are consecrated through the vows of poverty, chastity and obedience, and in this offering to God, we may live as either priests or lay missionaries. Our missionary formation is a ten year process, during which we study about our charism and place in the church, theology (and philosophy for members who desire to become priests), and other courses opportune to our apostolic work. In addition to this, we have an intense personal formation on a spiritual and human level. After this ten year preparation, we profess our perpetual vows of poverty, chastity and obedience and those who have the vocation to the priesthood may be ordained thereafter. Nonetheless, we consider formation to be a lifelong process and are committed to ongoing formation even after our initial formation is over.

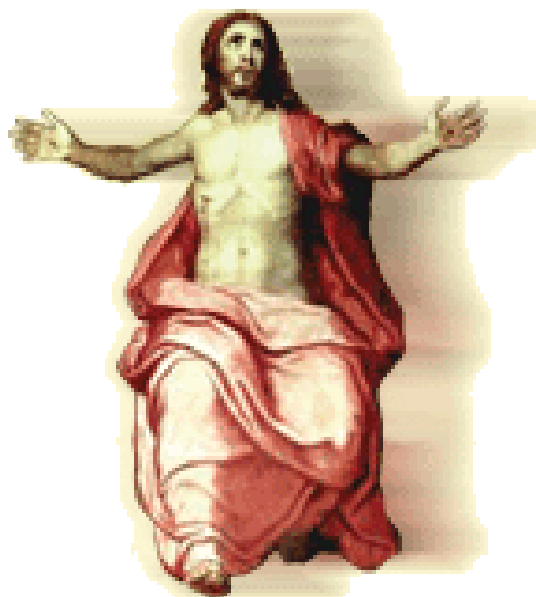
Once again I express my gratitude upon having received your scholarship, and, if I may appeal anew to your generosity, would like to do so. Because we are such a new Institute, the great majority of our members are still in their initial formation, and as such, we have many costs. Our only source of income are q group benefactors who contribute monthly , and a few larger fundraisers

that we promote throughout the year. Nonetheless, to give an idea of what our budget is like, on average, we must pay between 18 and 23 thousand reals per month in bills and other costs. Only between 12-15 thousand will come in from our benefactors. We try to clear our debts at the end of each semester with fundraisers, but in reality, we are more often than not in debt.

I earnestly commend myself and my community to your generosity and thank you already for everything that you have done until now. Truly, your greatest gift to us is prayer and I trust that even if you are not able to assist us financially, you will remember us in your prayers. This for us is already a great help!

May God bless you and Our Lady help to form you into perfect disciples and missionaries of Christ.

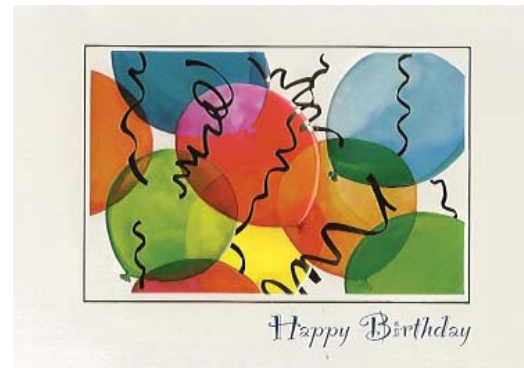
